



CYCLING TO SEE THE HANDLEBARDS AT CHILDERLEY / SUNDAY 15 SEPTEMBER

If you are coming to see The Handlebards perform *Much Ado About Nothing* at Childerley, we encourage you to cycle to the event if possible. For those coming from Cambridge, it's a pleasant afternoon ride of just over 8 miles and should take approximately 45 minutes. There will be cycle parking at Childerley and plenty of time after the event to cycle home in the light.

1) HEAD WEST FROM THE CITY CENTRE

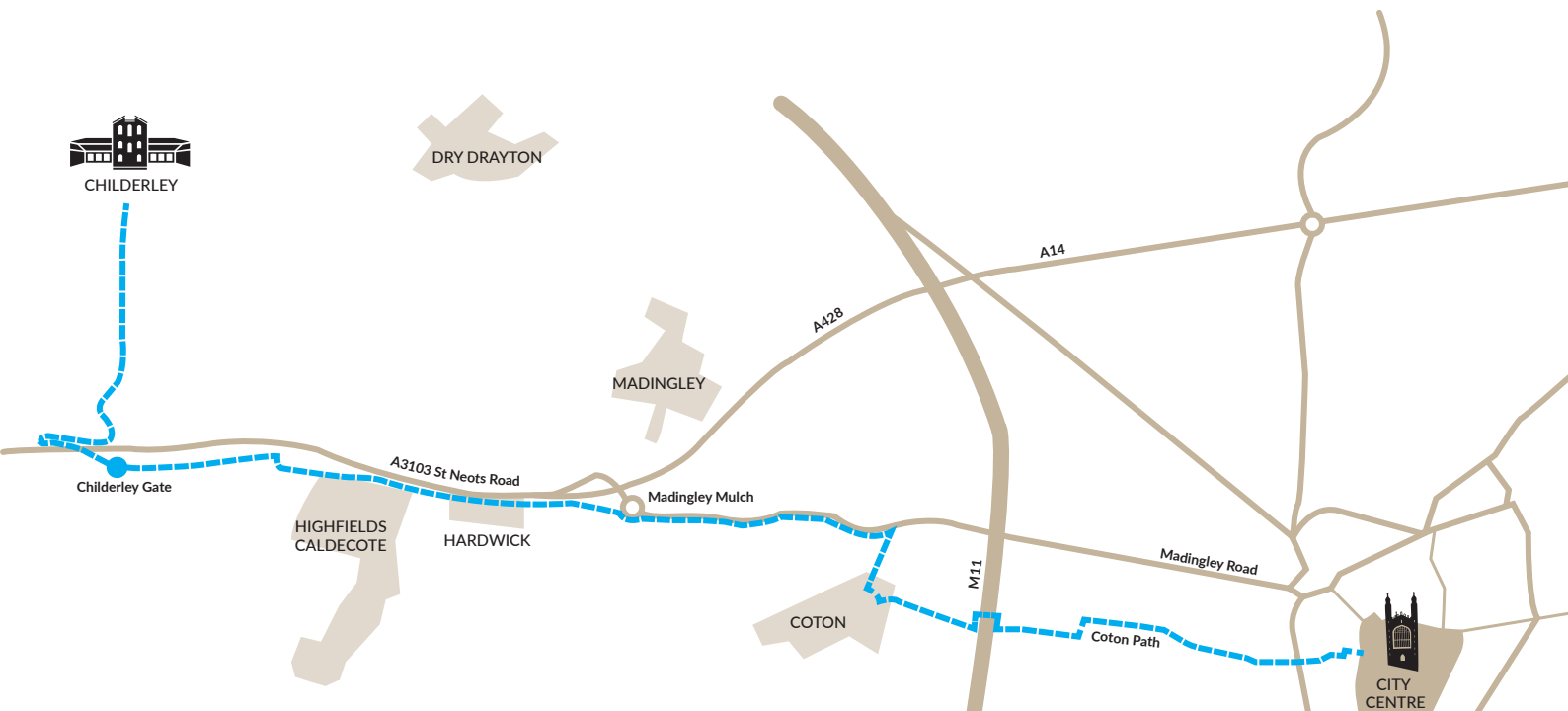
Cross the river at Garret Hostel Lane and continue west over Queens Road, passing the University Library on your way to Adams Road. Then take the Coton Path through West Cambridge and onto the bridge over the M11.

2) RIDE THROUGH COTON TO THE ST NEOTS ROAD

Continue through the village of Coton, cycling along the High Street past The Plough and turning right at the T-junction onto the Cambridge Road. At the end, turn left and join the shared-use path along the A1303. At Madingley Mulch, take the first left and follow the advisory lanes through Hardwick.

3) CROSS THE A428 AND TURN RIGHT AT THE CHILDERLEY JUNCTION

After passing a BP garage on your left, take the third exit at the Childerley Gate roundabout (signposted Bourn, Knapwell, Cambourne) which takes you over the A428. Then take the first right (signposted Childerley) onto the access road to the venue.
