

CamcycleQuest Prize Competition Terms and Conditions

1. By entering the prize competition you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.
2. This competition (CamcycleQuest) is being run by Cambridge Cycling Campaign ('Camcycle' / the 'Campaign' / 'we' / 'us') of The Bike Depot, 140 Cowley Road, Cambridge CB4 0DL.

Eligibility to enter

3. The competition is open to all who have participated in the CamcycleQuest.
4. In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win.
5. A maximum of one entry per individual and per CamcycleQuest guide is permitted.
6. The competition is free to enter however; it also requires completion of the CamcycleQuest which may either be purchased or given to the entrant free of charge through some workplaces or other community events.

How to enter

7. Online entries for the competition open at 12am on 1 August 2019 and close at noon on Thursday 19 September. Late entries will not be accepted.
8. Paper entries to the competition may be made, using the provided entry slip, at the Cargo Carnival event on Saturday 21 September at Lammas Land, 61 Newnham Rd, Cambridge CB3 9EY, before 1.45pm that day.
9. To enter the competition: entrants must complete the CamcycleQuest and calculate the answer to the CamcycleQuest competition clue. Entries must be completed online at www.cambridgefestivalofcycling.org/camcyclequest and only entries with correct answers to the competition clue will be included in the competition.
10. Cambridge Cycling Campaign will not accept responsibility if contact details provided are incomplete or inaccurate; or for competition entries that are lost or mislaid, or for competition entries with the incorrect answer.
11. Cambridge Cycling Campaign may request proof of a completed CamcycleQuest guide to determine eligibility and the subsequent award of prizes.

The prizes

12. The prizes will be a range of products and services donated to the Quest by local businesses and these will be advertised on the CamcycleQuest webpage.

13. Cambridge Cycling Campaign's use of particular brands as prizes does not imply any affiliation with or endorsement of such brands.
14. The winners will be drawn at random from entries that submitted the correct answer to the CamcycleQuest clue.
15. The prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be offered.
16. We reserve the right to substitute prizes with another prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to do so.
17. Cambridge Cycling Campaign accept no responsibility for inaccuracy of any prize description.
18. The decision of the Cambridge Cycling Campaign regarding any aspect of the competition is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.

Winner announcement

19. Winners will be announced at the Cargo Carnival on 21 September 2019 which will be held at Lammas Land, 61 Newnham Rd, Cambridge CB3 9EY. Winners not present at the Cargo Carnival will be notified after 21 September 2019 by email.
20. Cambridge Cycling Campaign will will make up to two attempts to contact winners by email. If contact is not made, Cambridge Cycling Campaign reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.

Claiming the prize

21. Winners will have 21 days from the date they were notified of winning to claim the prize by from the Cambridge Cycling Campaign offices (by appointment). Prizes will only be released following proof of identity. Where possible, Cambridge Cycling Campaign may be able to arrange delivery of prizes to people in the local area.
22. If a winner does not claim their prize within 21 days, they will lose their right to the prize.
23. If the winner cannot be contacted or has not claimed their prize within the required time limit, Cambridge Cycling Campaign reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.

Data protection and publicity

24. You consent to any personal information you provide in entering the competition being used by Cambridge Cycling Campaign for the purposes of administering the competition.
25. Winners agree to participate in any reasonable publicity related to the competition which may include the publication of their name and photograph in any media channel.

29. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of these Terms and Conditions. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Terms and Conditions shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein.
30. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
